Pandolea International's series of international conferences for sustainable development will start with **Food Education**.

After the presentation of its network during the 1<sup>st</sup> International Conference held last September, Pandolea, the association of Italian women entrepreneurs and professionals in the olive oil sector, launches the 2<sup>nd</sup> International Conference for sustainable development on the 24<sup>th</sup> of April 2021. The Conference inaugurates a series of dedicated events on four thematic areas, starting from **Food Education**.

Although the world is still fighting against the pandemic, hoping for an effective resolution with the ongoing worldwide vaccination campaign, PANDOLEA places emphasis on the topic of food education; in this sense, the establishment of a network of Mediterranean women in olive oil guarantees a shared commitment to carry out numerous food education projects with diversified targets and a view to sustainable development.

The network aims at spreading the culture of extra virgin olive oil in particular within the places of education, in schools, for the valorization of precious resource that is at the basis of Mediterranean cultures.

This event of considerable social and economic importance sees Italy and partner countries such as Greece, France, Jordan, Morocco, Spain and Tunisia as the protagonists, and will be hosted online on the Livestorm Platform, with the high patronage of the International Olive Council, the World Association of Agronomists, the Ministry of Agricultural Policies and other relevant institutions as CIHEAM of Bari, CONAF, CNPAPAL, the National Academy of Olive and Oil, ASviS, ISMEA, CREA and FOODINSIDER.

The day will start with opening remarks by Loriana Abbruzzetti, President of Pandolea, followed by the introduction to the special sessions by the Vice President Marcella Cipriani and various contributions on food education in line with the 2030 Agenda Goals.
